Graduation Rates

As of July 1, 2021, the graduation rate for students who began their post-secondary training at our school from September 1, 2017, through August 31, 2018, and for whom 150 percent of the normal time for program completion elapsed as of August 31, 2020, is presented in the following calculations:

Of the 92 students who began school, 0 students were qualified for an exclusion from the cohort. Of the 92 students, 67 completed their coursework and graduated within the allowed timeframe. Therefore, the school's graduation rate for those students is 73 percent.

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Please Note:

1. Graduation rates do not include students who left the school to serve in the armed forces, on official church missions, or in the foreign service of the federal government. Students who died or were totally and permanently disabled are also excluded.
2. Graduation rates include first-time, full-time students only. A first-time student is defined as a student who is entering college for the first time during that cohort period.
